Biographical Sketch / Administrative History

Dennis Henry Stephen Gruending was born in St. Benedict, Saskatchewan on May 18, 1948. Educated locally and at St. Peter's College, Muenster, Gruending earned a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in English from the University of Saskatchewan (1970, 1984) and a Masters in Journalism from Carleton University (1996).

From 1971 to 1989 Gruending worked as a journalist in print, radio and television primarily in Saskatchewan. In this period he also worked as a freelance contributor (*Five Nights, Capital Report*) radio host (*Wheels*; *CBC Morning Edition*), radio producer (*Saskatchewan Today*), and television reporter (*24 Hours*) for the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation.

Between 1979 and 1981 he also worked for the social action department of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Regina. Gruending toured extensively in Central and South America in the late 1970s and was a member of the 1982 Saskatchewan Trade Union Tour to Nicaragua.

Leaving radio broadcasting to pursue freelance writing interests in 1989, Gruending moved to Ontario where he spent four years as director of information for the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in the mid-1990s. He settled in Ottawa.

Elected to federal Parliament as the New Democratic Party (NDP) member for Saskatoon-Rosetown-Biggar in a 1999 by-election, Gruending served as NDP critic for International Development and the Environment. He lost his seat in the federal election of 2000 and ran unsuccessfully in 2004.

Gruending maintained ties in Saskatoon and Ottawa. He has held membership in the Association of Canadian Television and Radio Artists (ACTRA); Amnesty International; The Writers' Union of Canada (National Council); the Saskatchewan Writers' Guild; PEN International (English-Canadian Section) and the Committee for Investigative Journalism, Saskatchewan Branch. Gruending received the City of Regina Writers' Award (1980), the Saskatchewan Writers' Guild Award for Non-Fiction (1981) and national awards for farm writing and religious journalism.

Dennis Gruending married Martha Wiebe and has two daughters: Maria and Anna. Currently (2006) Gruending is involved in writing, research and communications planning in Ottawa, Ontario.

Primarily a writer of non-fiction, Gruending has also written poetry and short fiction. He is the author of numerous articles, stories and poems appearing in NeWest Review, The Canadian Forum, New Internationalist, Maclean's, This Magazine and Reader's Digest and has contributed to many anthologies. His books include: Gringo: Poems and Journals from Latin America (Coteau Books, 1983); Emmett Hall: Establishment Radical (Macmillan of Canada, 1985; revised and updated: Fitzhenry and Whiteside, 2005); Promises to Keep: A Political Biography of Allan Blakeney (Western Producer Prairie Books, 1990), The Middle of Nowhere: Rediscovering Saskatchewan (Fifth House, 1996); and Great Canadian Speeches (Fitzhenry and Whiteside, 2004).

This fonds consists of records created, accumulated and used by Dennis Gruending during the course of his career as a writer, journalist, radio host and producer, and television reporter in Regina, Saskatchewan. Some material in the fonds also relates to his writing career in Ottawa, Ontario.

The types of records included are research notes, general correspondence, transcripts, interview question sheets, sound recordings of interviews, photographs, manuscript drafts, speeches, radio broadcasts, editor and reviewer correspondence. The records principally relate to Gruending's books *Gringo: Poems and Journals from Latin America* (Coteau Books, 1983); *Emmett Hall: Establishment Radical* (Macmillan of Canada, 1985 ed.); and *Promises to Keep: A Political Biography of Allan Blakeney* (Western Producer Prairie Books, 1990).

Also included is material related to Gruending's work with CBC radio and television, and his freelance journalism in Saskatchewan.

Gruending's records created as a federal New Democratic Party Member of Parliament for the Saskatoon-Rosetown-Biggar constituency are not included in the fonds.

The records described in 1992 consist of seven series: *Emmett Hall: Establishment Radical; Promises to Keep: A Political Biography of Allan Blakeney*; Speeches and Workshops; Organizations; Writing; Radio and Television Journalism; Miscellaneous. An Addendum series including CBC radio material, speeches and workshop material and poetry readings was added in 1993.

The sound recordings and photographs described in 2002 and 2003 relate to the earlier material in the fonds. A list and transcripts to interviews conducted for *Promises to Keep* has been added at File II.54.

Introduction

Dennis Gruending was born in Cudworth in 1948. He was educated at St. Benedict and at St. Peter's College, Muenster. He received a BA in English from the University of Saskatchewan in 1970 and an Honours certificate in 1984.

From 1971 to 1988 Gruending worked as a journalist in print, radio and television in Saskatchewan. He is the author of *Gringo* (1983), a book of poetry and journal entries from a trip to Central and South America in 1977-1978, and two biographies: *Emmett Hall: Establishment Radical* (1958) and *Promises* to *Keep: A Political Biography of Allan Blakeney* (1990) as well as many poems, stories and articles.

The papers described herein were donated to Saskatchewan Archives
Board on November 4, 1992 and January 29, 1993 and assigned Accession
Nos. R92-285 and R93-13 respectively. Section I contains research
material and drafts of Emmett Hall. Section II contains research
material and drafts of Promises to Keep. The remaining sections contain
papers related to other writing projects and to aspects of Gruending's
career in journalism. Biographical information will be found in file
