Brief Bio./Admin. History Elwood Roberts was born in Ontario in 1886. He and his wife Bertha relocated to Cupar, Saskatchewan, ca. 1909. Elwood Roberts and his brother Norman established the Roberts Bros. general store in Cupar in 1909. The store remained in operation until 1945 when Elwood and Bertha Roberts moved to British Columbia. They died in 1946 and 1973, respectively. Their son, Wayne Eugene Roberts, was born in Cupar in 1910. He married Bernice Abel in 1937. They lived in Cupar until ca. 1940 when they moved first to Regina ca. 1940 and subsequently to British Columbia in 1944. They had two sons: James and Gerald. Wayne and Bernice Roberts died in 1953 and 1993, respectively. Currently (2011), Gerald Roberts resides in British Columbia.

Biographical Sketch/Administrative History

Elwood Roberts was born in Drayton, Ontario, in 1886 to David and Lydia (Reichert) Roberts. He married Bertha Louise H. Hopkins, daughter of Albert and Mary Ann (Sootheran) Hopkins, on April 29, 1907, in Victoria County, Ontario. They relocated to Cupar, Saskatchewan, ca. 1909 where Elwood's brother Norman (born in 1882) was manager of the Cupar branch of the A.E. Beach Co. Ltd. store. In 1909, Elwood and Norman Roberts purchased the A.E. Beach Co. Ltd. store in Cupar and established Roberts Bros., a general store under the corporate brand of The Big Red Store. In the years following, Norman Roberts left the business and relocated to Toronto, Ontario. He died there on October 2, 1934. Elwood Roberts continued as proprietor of the Roberts Bros. store until October 1945 when he sold the business and he and Bertha relocated to Osoyoos, British Columbia. He died at Oliver, British Columbia, on March 17, 1946. Bertha Roberts died in 1973.

Elwood and Bertha Roberts had one son, Wayne Eugene, who was born in Cupar on March 22, 1910. He married Bernice Abel, daughter of Walter and Annie (Close) Abel, on March 2, 1937, in Regina. Wayne and Bernice Roberts relocated from Cupar to Regina ca. 1940, and then to British Columbia in 1944. They had two sons: James Alan Yardley and Gerald Wayne. Wayne Roberts died in Osoyoos, British Columbia, on November 1, 1953. Bernice Roberts died in British Columbia in 1993.

Gerald Wayne Roberts was born on February 9, 1944, in Regina to Wayne and Bernice Roberts. Soon after his birth, the family relocated to British Columbia. Roberts was educated there and earned a Bachelor's degree in Anthropology. He was a professional archeologist and was involved in various archeological salvage projects throughout British Columbia. Roberts married Gisela Greschner on August 2, 1969. They have one daughter, Sharon. Currently, (2011) Gerald Roberts is retired and resides in Osoyoos.

Scope and Content

This fonds consists of records created, accumulated and used by the Elwood Roberts family of Cupar, Saskatchewan, between 1911 and 1952. The fonds includes business records created between 1911 and 1945 that relate to the Roberts Bros. general store in Cupar that was operated by Elwood Roberts and his brother Norman. The fonds also consists of photographs created and accumulated by Elwood Roberts' son Wayne, primarily from the 1930s and 1940s. Subject matter of the photographs includes members of the Roberts family, and buildings, events and residents of Cupar and district. Subjects also include the 1939 Royal Visit of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth to Regina, the 1935 Muscowpetung Sports Day, and the Swift Current Frontier Days exhibition. Additionally, the fonds includes family tree information for the Roberts and Abel families and their descendents.

The types of records included are: photographs; negatives; land transfer and sale agreement records; land registration abstracts; mortgages; loan account payment receipts; and correspondence.

No series assignment has been applied to the records in this fonds.
