#### Biographical Sketch

Frank Joseph Patrick Crean was born in Dublin, Ireland to Michael and Emma Crean on March 6, 1875, the seventh of eight children. He is thought to have attended Belvedere College [in Dublin?], and in 1899 he served with the 1st Royal Dragoons, Robert's Horse in South Africa. It appears that Frank Crean first came to Canada in 1903 where he took a job with Bell Brothers Lumber Company of Prince Albert "cruising" timber. In February, 1908, he accepted a post with the Railway Lands Branch, Department of the Interior. In August, 1908, he was chosen to head a small party to travel into north-eastern Alberta and north-western Saskatchewan to evaluate the land, climate. vegetation, and animal life to determine the area's agricultural potential, and to see if it would be satisfactory for settlement. This expedition, referred to as the New Northwest Exploration Expedition, was initially planned to last the one summer, but was extended to two after Crean submitted the first of two formal reports in April, 1909. The final formal report was submitted by Crean to the Department of the Interior on May 2, 1910.

In January 1909, Frank Crean married Josephine Mary Gigot in Nelson BC. The couple had no children. His employment with the Department of the Interior ended in 1913 when he resigned his position. In January 1915, Crean enlisted in the Canadian Army, but by March 1916, he was discharged without seeing action. Frank Crean died December 18, 1932.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of two photograph albums with a total of 329 b&w prints, and 8 cm of textual records. The photographs, most taken by Crean, document the travels of the New Northwest Exploration expedition, under the leadership of Frank Crean, and instructed by the Department of the Interior to evaluate and report back on the land in the area to determine its agricultural potential. The expedition made two, and possibly three trips from 1908-1910, and covered portions of north-eastern Alberta and

north-western Saskatchewan.

The textual records consist of a scrapbook containing newspaper clippings dealing with exploration in the Canadian north-west ca. 1905-1910, copies of correspondence between Crean and his superiors at the Department of the Interior pertaining to his expedition and various issues that arose during that time, as well as a

copy of a ca. 1931 report by Frank Crean entitled, "The Winnipeg and English Rivers Prior to Power

Development."
