**Biographical Sketch /
Administrative History** Keith Napoleon Goulet was born on April 3, 1946 in Cumberland House, Saskatchewan to Arthur Goulet and Veronique Carriere. He is one of eleven children. Goulet attended Charlebois School in Cumberland House and Riverside Collegiate in Prince Albert. After attending teacher's college in Ontario, he earned a Bachelor of Education degree in 1974 from the University of Saskatchewan and a Master of Education degree in 1986 from the University of Regina.

Prior to entering provincial politics, Goulet worked as an elementary school teacher, sessional lecturer at the University of Saskatchewan and Cree language consultant. He was also a Northern Teacher Education Program (NORTEP) developer, principal of La Ronge Community College and executive director of the Gabriel Dumont Institute of Metis Studies and Applied Research.

Goulet was first elected to the Saskatchewan Legislature in 1986 as a New Democratic Party (NDP) MLA for the Cumberland constituency. He was re-elected in 1991, 1995 and 1999. The first Metis Cabinet Minister in Saskatchewan, Goulet served in the Romanow Cabinet as Provincial Secretary (1992-1993); Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Government Insurance (1992-1995); Associate Minister of Education (1993); Associate Minister of Education, Training and Employment (1993-1995); Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Computer Utility Corporation (1995); Minister of Northern Affairs (1995-2001); and Minister Responsible for the Office of Northern Affairs (1995-2001).

Goulet retired from Cabinet on October 12, 2001 and vacated his seat in the Legislature in 2003. Joan Beatty (NDP) became MLA for Cumberland constituency on November 5, 2003.

Goulet currently (2006) resides in Regina.

Goulet married Linda May Hemingway on August 31, 1974. They have two children: Koonu and Danis.

Goulet served as a New Democratic Party (NDP) member in the Saskatchewan Legislature for the Cumberland constituency (1986-2003) and as a Cabinet Minister in the Roy Romanow Government (1992-2001).</p> <p>Goulet retired from political life in November, 2003. Direct Acquisition from Records Creator	Keith Goulet donated these records to the Regina office, Saskatchewan Archives in two accessions in 2000 and 2001: R2000-043 (February 7, 2000); and R2001-204 (May 29, 2001). The records were transferred from Goulet's ministerial office.

Scope and Content	<p>This fonds consists of records created, accumulated and used from 1995 to 2000 by Keith Goulet in his political career as Minister of Northern Affairs.</p> <p>The fonds includes a small volume of records created by Goulet as Associate Minister of Education; Associate Minister of Education, Training and Employment and Member of the Saskatchewan Legislative Assembly. These records are interfiled with the Northern Affairs records.</p> <p>This fonds contains public and political records.</p> <p>The fonds consists of one series: Minister of Northern Affairs. The series was arranged into six sub-series: Minister's Office; Northern Towns and Villages; Forestry; Northern Health; Mining; and Trapping.</p> <p>The types of records included are correspondence, memoranda, briefing notes, legislation, reports, publications, speaking notes, news releases and an electronic record.</p> <p>The fonds is missing MLA and constituency material and records created by Goulet as Provincial Secretary; Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Government Insurance; Minister Responsible for Saskatchewan Computer Utility Corporation; and Minister Responsible for the Office of Northern Affairs.</p>
