The Regina Lyric Light Opera Society had its beginnings in the St. Mathew's (Anglican) Operatic and Choral Society, which was founded by Reverend William Holsworth Adcock in 1922. The name of the Society was changed to the Lyric Light Opera Society in 1941-1942 following Reverend Adcock's return to England.

The Society flourished in the Regina until 1951. Between the mid-1950s and 1978, musical theatre continued to develop through the Regina Little Theatre. The Regina Lyric Light Opera Society was re-established in November 1977 under the guidance of Patricia Knox-Moore. It's constitution and bylaws were modelled on the original Society.

The Regina Lyric Light Opera Society exists as a volunteer community organization to promote, develop, and sponsor the art of musical theatre, and in particular, local Saskatchewan talent. Sponsorship of the Society is received from Saskatchewan Lotteries, the Regina Arts Commission, the Saskatchewan Choral Federation, individuals and businesses.

The Society presents variety shows and one major musical production each year. These productions have included *H.M.S. Pinafore* (1978), *The Red Mill* (1979), *The Pirates of Penzance* (1980), *Showboat* (1981), *The Mikado* (1982), *Fiddler on the Roof* (1983), *The Gondoliers* (1984), *The Dancing Years* (1985), *Oklahoma!* (1986), *Guys and Dolls* (1987), *La Vie Parisienne* (1988), *The Music Man* (1989), *The Merry Widow* (1990), *Kiss Me Kate* (1991), *the Boys From Syracuse* (1992), and *Die Fleder Maus* (1993).

The records in this accession relate to the re-established Society. Included are newsletters, bulletins, programmes, bylaws, correspondence, executive lists, membership lists, and minutes of meetings. Earlier records of the organization are available in our holdings in collection R-465.

The records in this listing were collected by Harold Sheard, a member of the Society. They were transferred to the Archives Board on 20 June 1995 and on 22 September 1986, and were assigned accession numbers R95-218 and R86-474, respectively.
