## A CHECKLIST OF THE RECORDS OF THE SASKATCHEWAN WAFFLE

Saskatchewan Archives Board, Regina 1990

#### Introduction

The Waffle was a caucus of the federal New Democratic Party (NDP) which called for a major ideological reorientation of the party. The Waffle policy statement, "For an Independent Socialist Canada," was debated and defeated at the federal NDP convention in October 1969.

Woodrow Lloyd, then leader of the Saskatchewan NDP, supported the controversial Waffle initiative and was consequently forced to resign the leadership by the NDP legislative caucus in March 1970. Later that month, the Saskatchewan Waffle was founded. Don Mitchell ran for leader as a Waffle candidate and finished second with 25% of the vote.

The Waffle remained a significant minority within the Saskatchewan NDP for the next two years. Waffle calls for a land bank and a crown-owned petroleum corporation were reflected in the NDP platform for the 1971 election campaign.

Tensions between the NDP and the Waffle grew, however, on both the federal and provincial levels. In 1972, the Ontario NDP expelled the Waffle. In the federal election that November, the Saskatchewan Waffle ran an issue-oriented campaign independent of the NDP. The following year a Saskatchewan Waffle convention voted to split from the NDP.

Following its departure from the NDP, the Waffle was racked by internal debates about its role and policies. During 1975 and 1976 several groups and individuals left the organization. By 1983, only a handful of members remained. They dissolved the Waffle and attempted to regroup as the Saskatchewan Union for Independence and Socialism. The latter group died in April 1984.

This collection consists of papers collected by John Warnock from

several people who participated in the Waffle at various stages in its development. Dr. Warnock conducted taped interviews with some of the same people, which are listed in Section XI, and wrote a series of articles on the history of the Waffle for <u>Briarpatch</u> magazine (see file number I.D.1). The collection was donated to the Saskatchewan Archives Board by Dr. Warnock on 22 November 1989 and was assigned Accession No. R89-412.

Researchers should note that Dr. Warnock's personal papers, which are held in the Saskatoon office of the Saskatchewan Archives Board, contain additional Saskatchewan Waffle material from the early 1970s. They are listed in GS 130. Collection R-1217 which is included in this guide also consists of records of the Saskatchewan Waffle.

The records listed herein were received from Glen Hamilton on 6 September 1990 and assigned Accession No. R90-243. The Collection No. is R-1423. The collection includes materials collected by the donor during his membership in the Saskatchewan Waffle, materials collected by other Waffle members, and records held by the offices of Next Year Country, the official organ of the Waffle, at the time of the magazine's demise. The records had been in the donor's hands for several years.

Where original order could be discerned, it was followed. The collection is divided into two series: records of the Saskatchewan Waffle and records of Next Year Country. Files containing routine financial information, subscription correspondence and book orders were removed from the collection and discarded. Many file folders were replaced for conservation reasons. Existing file titles were used where they reflected the file content fairly accurately. In other cases, file titles were supplied.

Copies of Next Year Country magazine itself were discarded. A complete set of the magazine is held in section I.C of Saskatchewan Archives Board collection R-1284, listed in a previous section of this guide. A microfiche copy of volumes 4 and 5 of the magazine is held by the Saskatchewan Archives Board and listed in section I.E of this collection. Periodicals collected by the magazine and listed in section I.D were microfilmed and are available on reel no. R-1.983.
