DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT.



In the Matter of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 20  
Township 31 Range 22W of the 7th Meridian  
Homestead Pre-emption

I, William Henry McLeod,  
of the village of Manor, Saskatchewan, blacksmith  
do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry y for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at  
Regina on the 23rd day  
of May 1905, and I now ask to have said entry y cancelled,  
and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:

land, and I have learned since that  
there is not enough grain raising lands  
on same.

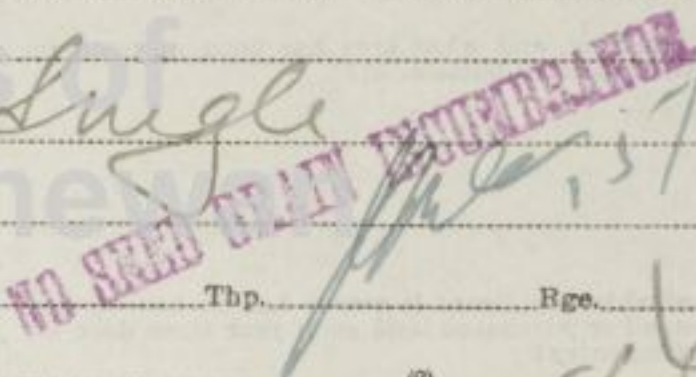
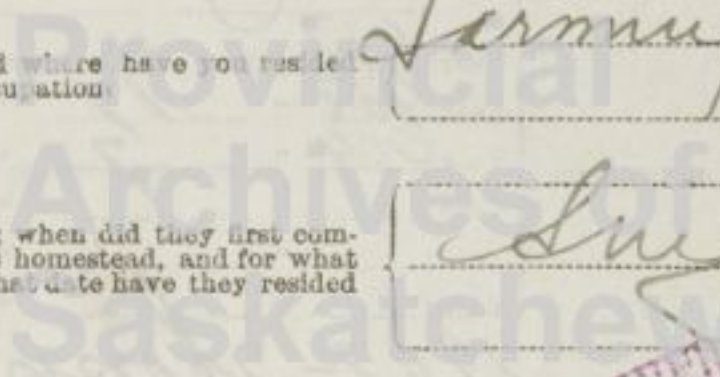
