DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT.

Memo

In the Matter of the R. S. 1/4 of Section 26
Township 28 Range 15 W. of the 2nd Meridian
Homestead Pre-emption

I, Thomas Corner of
Wishart

do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at
Neulawa on the 10th day
of April 1905, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled,
and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:
