DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT.

In the Matter of the North West 1/4 of Section 28
Township 46 Range 5 W of the 3rd Meridian
Homestead Pre-emption



I, Delmer H. Coonfare of
Hampton North Dakota

do solemnly declare :-

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at
Prince Albert on or about 8th day
of December 1904, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled,
and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely :
