I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th ultimo, and in reply to say that it will be necessary for you and your son to pay fresh fees when making entry for lands in lieu of your respective homesteads which you have been permitted to abandon. I may explain that the Department expects a settler to satisfy himself as to the suitability of the land he enters for, and the only exception allowed in the matter of fees is where through ignorance of the English language or the destruction of the survey posts or for some other equally good reason an entry has been wrongly made.

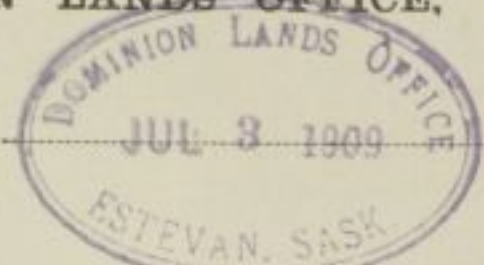

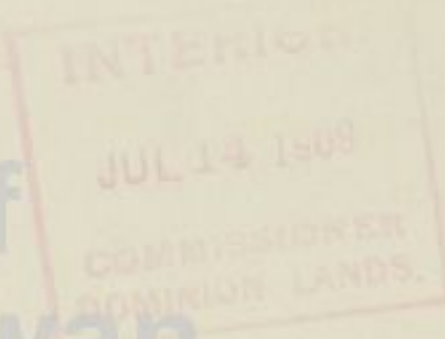
