It appears that an error has been committed in recording this lien against property which did not belong to the applicant who was supplied with the seed grain. The Department has recourse against Airth. He is responsible, but according to the correspondence his present address cannot be procured. There does not appear to be any other sourse open to the Department than to return the money to Mr. Stalder; and take action against Airth when his whereabouts can be ascertain. ed. It looks as if the Department may have to lose this money. Mr. Dempster writing to the Regina Seed Grain Office on the 26th February, 1908, notified them that Mr. Airth's name did not appear in any connection whatever with the N.W. 2-30-23-W.2 M., and notwithstanding this the lien was made out against the above mentioned land.

My information is that the Half Section in question is assessed for \$950.00 only, and with the improvements at current prices, would not sell for more than \$1,500.00 at the present time. It is extremely doubtful if a buyer could be found at this figure. My client has no knowledge whatsoever of the lien, other than it contained a lien appearing on the Duplicate Certificate of Title, and is of the opinion that it may have been settled and the discharge of the same has been overlooked. I will be pleased if you will look into this matter and advise me of the present situation with regard to the lien, and ifthere is still avalid and subsisting and proposition charge against the land, the lowest amount you would be prepared to accept in a settlement. 
