to be a British subject unless he has ceased to be a subject
(or citizen) of that state, in pursuance of the laws thereof,
or in pursuance of a treaty of convention to that effect.

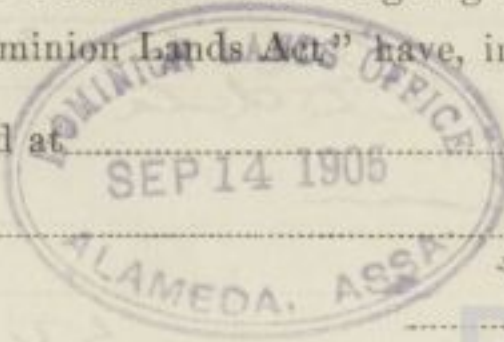
