DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT.



In the Matter of the SE Quarter of Section 2
Township 33 Range 14 of the 2nd Meridian
Homestead Entry Pre-emption



I, H. S. Walter of

do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at
Yorkton assa. on the 14th day
of may 1904, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled,
and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:

with alkali to much for farming
