DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT.



In the Matter of the S. W. 4 of Section 32  
Township 18 Range 2 West of the 3rd Meridian  
Homestead yes Pre-emption



I, Cecil W. McKeenna late of Austin & now residing near Portage la Prairie, Manitoba  
do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at Regina by mail on the 31st day of July 1905, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled, and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:

- (1) Because I was not able to go on to the one I am now cancelling owing to a death which puts me back a little financially.
- (2) I have not resided on the homestead but have been working for a farmer in the district of Austin Manitoba for the past three years.
