DECLARATION OF ABANDONMENT

In the Matter of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 16
Township 23 Range 8 West of the 3 Meridian
Homestead ~~Pre-emption~~

I, Ford C. Austin of
Smith's Falls, Ont.

do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at
Davidson on the 16 day
of Sept 1905, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled,
and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:

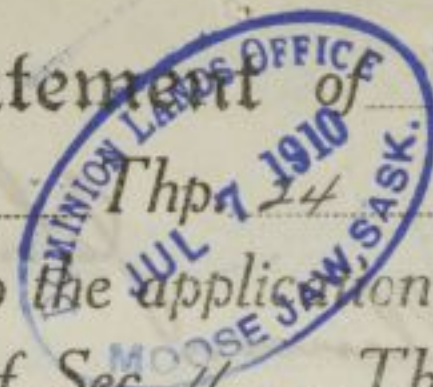

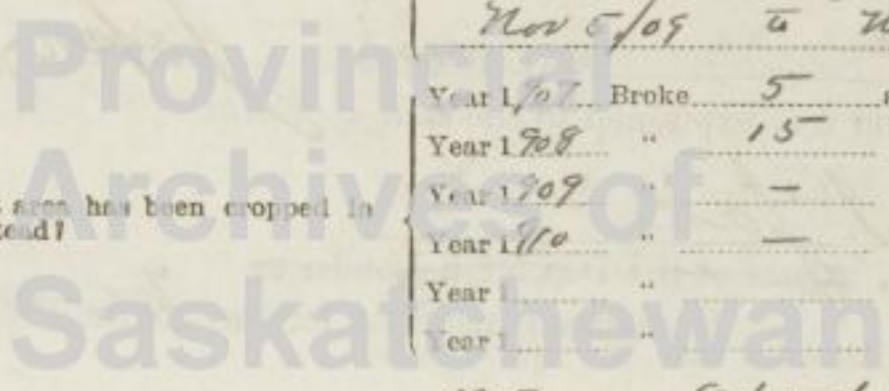
