DOMINION OF CANADA---NORTH-WEST TERRITORIES.

Before the Honourable EDWARD LUDLOW WETMORE, one of the Judges of the Supreme Court of the
Northwest Territories.

WHEREAS **Huron Spencer Ball,**

formerly of **the State of South Dakota** in the republic of the U. S. A.

now of **Yorkton,**

North-West Territories of the Dominion of Canada, **Teamster**
has complied with the several requirements of "The Naturalization Act" and has duly resided in Canada
for the period of three years.

And whereas the certificate granted to the said **Huron Spencer Ball**
under the tenth section of the said Act has, under and by virtue of the regulations made in that behalf
by His Excellency the Governor-General of Canada, and approved on the Twenty-ninth day of January,
in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-nine, and of the Provisions of the
Statutes in such case made and provided, been presented to me.

And whereas I have taken such means as appear to me to be necessary in this case to satisfy myself
that the facts stated in said certificate are true and I am satisfied that the facts so stated in such
certificate are true.

This is therefore to certify to all to whom it may come, that under and by virtue of said Act
Huron Spencer Ball, has become a British subject and is within
Canada entitled to all political and other rights and privileges and is subject to all obligations to which
a natural born British subject is entitled or subject, within Canada, with this qualification, that he shall
not within the limits of the Foreign State of which he was a subject previous to the date hereof be
deemed to be a British subject, unless he has ceased to be a subject of that State, in pursuance of the
laws thereof, or in pursuance of a Treaty or Convention to that effect.

In witness whereof I have, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said regulations
and by the statutes aforesaid, hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Supreme Court of the
North-West Territories, Judicial District of Eastern Assiniboia, to be hereunto affixed this

9th day of **May,** A.D. 1902.
