In the Matter of the NW of Section 28 Township 23 Range 5 of the 3 Meridian Homestead Pre-emption

I, Malcolm Beaton Davidson

do solemnly declare:—

That I made entry for the above mentioned lands at the Dominion Lands Office at Davidson on the 5 day of August 1905, and I now ask to have said entry cancelled, and be permitted to take up another homestead for the following reasons, namely:
